Replacing the Projection Lamp

The lamp hour timer in the Service Info menu counts the number of hours the lamp has been in use. When the timer reaches 2000 hours, the Alarm LED lights red, indicating that it is time to change the lamp. You can order new lamp housings from your InFocus dealer.

Follow these steps to replace the projection lamp:

- I Turn off the projector and unplug the power cord.
- **2** Wait 60 minutes to allow the projector to cool thoroughly.
- **3** Turn the projector upside down and loosen the captive screw on the lamp door.



- **4** Insert the screwdriver in the tab on the lamp door and pry the door up.
- **5** Loosen the three captive screws on the lamp housing.



WARNING: To avoid burns, allow the projector to cool for at least 60 minutes before you replace the lamp. Never extract the lamp housing while the projector is operating.



WARNING: Be extremely careful when removing the lamp housing. In the unlikely event that the bulb ruptures, small glass fragments may be generated. The lamp module is designed to contain these fragments, but use caution when removing the lamp module.



6 Carefully remove the lamp housing. Dispose of the lamp in an environmentally proper manner.



- **7** Install the new lamp housing and tighten the screws.
- **8** Replace the lamp door.
- **9** Plug in the power cord, press the Power switch, then press the **Power** button to turn the projector back on.
- **10** To reset the lamp hour timer, navigate to the Setup/Service menu and choose Reset lamptimer.



WARNING: Do not drop the lamp module or touch the glass bulb! The glass may shatter and cause injury.
